He was born in Nola (Italy) on 11 August 1948.

He graduated in Medicine and Surgery (1975) and specialized in General Surgery (1980) at the University “Federico II” in Naples and in Digestive Surgery (1982) at the University “La Sapienza” in Rome.

1979 – 1981 Foreign Assistant of Université Paris VI – France in Digestive Surgery at Hospital Saint Antoine, directed by J. Loygue; in Paris he worked with C. Huguet, R. Parc, H. Bismuth and M. Malafosse.

1981 during the second semester, he worked with Professor Ton That Tung in Surgical Department the Viet-Duc Hospital – University of Hanoi – Vietnam.

2000 He worked at the University of Tokyo with M. Makuuci and at the University of Kyoto with K. Tanaka on the advanced hepatic surgery and the liver transplantation with living donor.

2007-2009 He collaborates at Illinois University in Chicago – United States in the Department of Surgery with P.C. Giulianotti and E. Benedetti on advanced laparoscopic and robotic surgery.

Until 2017 he was a Professor at General Surgery Post-Graduate School of Medicine at the University “Federico II”- Naples.

2017 he is Professor of Robotic Surgery at Federico II University of Naples – Italy. His main field of interest has always been Hepato-Biliary-Pancreatic and Gastro-Enteric and Colon-Rectum Surgery.

Currently he is mainly interested in Advanced Laparoscopic and Robotic Surgery.

Author of 135 scientific publications. He has performed over 10.000 operations.

In 1995, in Athens, at International Hepato-Biliary-Pancreatic Association (I.H.P.B.A.), he won the First Video Prize.
